The London Plane requires regular trimming to manage the growth of the tree and ensure that the canopy does reach the road. The small Silver Birch at the rear of the garden requires light maintenance to trim and shape the branches. For the established Yew tree at the rear of the area, works are proposed to remove the lower branches and lift the canopy of the tree to make the area move visible and discourage ASB. The clerk has contacted Thompson Tree Services who have submitted a quote. The caretakers will clear the undergrowth and trim the shrubbery to tidy the area further.
