ET20/88 Implementation of Government Climate Change Policy at a Local Level

A resident has contacted the council regarding the local application of national government climate change policy and seeking support/engagement of the council.

RECOMMEND this committee recommends to the Council the following policy: In the light of the Council's declaration of a climate emergency, the Council's presumption on planning applications for the installation of solar panels and of wind turbines should be of approval throughout the Council's area of authority. Proposals that the Council object to approval in particular cases should be discussed by the Full Council. The Committee further recommends that the issue of the installation of equipment designed to counteract the climate emergency should be covered in the forthcoming revision of the Neighbourhood Plan. That the council communicate this policy to both the District and County Council.

ET20/89 Power for People local Electricity Bill (Climate Change WP)

Proposal to WTC to add their support for this proposed bill and to write to Sarah Dines to request to add her support for this bill which has cross party support.

RECOMMEND the matter be referred to Full Council for discussion and approval.

ET20/90 Swift boxes for the Town Hall / Memorial Hall (Climate Change WP)

Proposal for boxes to be installed on Town Council Buildings (St Mary's Church installing 4 boxes).

RECOMMEND that the matter be deferred with a further review and discussion to be triggered by either guidance from Derbyshire Wildlife Trust, community groups or councillors.

ET20/91 Inconsiderate Parking Complaint

A resident has complained about the parking near to Ecclesbourne Close and Water Lane Junction obstructing view of traffic. The Police have suggested contacting WTC to enquire regarding traffic restrictions.

RECOMMEND that the matter be deferred for 6 weeks pending the elections for a new representative Councillor at Derbyshire County Council. The council should then seek a meeting with the new elected councillor to raise this and other matters under County Council responsibility.
