ET23/127 Parking Restrictions and Yellow Lines

Concerns have been raised that in some areas of the town, there are no explanatory signs stating parking restrictions at the site of the yellow lines (with the potential consequence that these restrictions are not enforceable). Also, where yellow lines have become faded away or obstructed then restrictions also may not be enforceable. The concern was that our current yellow lines are in disrepair.

REC that Cllr Maskrey contact C Cllr D Murphy and Highways Officer to raise the concerns over the missing parking enforcement signs (e.g. Causeway Lane), the worn, deteriorating/fragmented yellow lines on most central streets (e.g. Coldwell St, North End and Causeway Lane). That Cllr Maskrey contact DDDC to raise the matter given the impact on efficacy of parking enforcement.

That the Clerk make a report via the DCC online portal to record the fault with the missing Parking enforcement sign.

ET23/128 Harrison Drive Pavement

The gulley alongside the Harrison Drive retaining wall has been cleaned but all the debris was left alongside the gulley which negates the benefits of the work.

REC that the Clerk contact C Cllr Murphy to thank him for prompting the cleaning of the gulley as evidenced by the debris that is now left adjacent to it and to now enquire what will be Highways next action(s) to tackle the issue as the gulley continues to discharge water on to the footway.
